If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately you should inform the club's Child Protection Officer immediately.

If photographs e.g. team or action shots, are submitted to the Press or published on the Club's website individuals may be identified.

Please note: The Club understands that there are circumstances under which a parent would not wish their child to be photographed. Whilst the Club will do all it can to ensure the safety of children during matches, it is the responsibility of the parent concerned to ensure that if necessary, their child is not photographed or videoed. The Club is unable to supervise individual children during tennis activities or competitions.

Club Changing Policy

All parents must be aware that there are circumstances under which players under the age of 16 years may find themselves changing clothes in the presence of persons over 18 years. The Club requests that if any parent is not comfortable with this arrangement then it is their responsibility to ensure the following:

- Young players who do not wish to change or shower with adults are under no obligation to do so and are advised to change and shower at home.
- Parental consent must be given if Young Players are to share changing facilities with adults.
- It is the responsibility of the parent concerned to ensure that their child does not enter changing facilities at any time if consent is not given.
